


- Global Tensions: Global tensions have been heightened in the past two years, making the demand for aerospace and defense products strong
- Demand for air travel: Commercial air travel heightened post-pandemic, leading to increased demand for new aircrafts and after-market products and services

Headwinds

Supply Chain Issues: Global supply chain issues have made obtaining parts for Aerospace and Defense products difficult, delaying many deliveries

Labor Issues: Weak labor forces within the supply chain, as well as trouble attracting talent for aerospace and defense companies

Vladimir Putin announces a "special military operation" in Ukraine. Russian forces began invading and Ukraine broke off relations.

Hamas announces start of Operation Al-Aqsa Flood, firing over 5,000 rockets from into Israel. Hamas militants invade Gaza Strip. Israel fights and vows to destroy Hamas.

Hamas vows to repeat October 7 attacks until Israel is annihilated. South Africa files case against Israel at International Court of Justice, alleging Israel's conduct in Gaza as genocide.

Fighting continues, and United States congress began passing a bill that would make it easier to send weapons to Ukraine, the beginning of several aid packages.

Houthis hijacked a commercial ship in Red Sea and have since attacked more than two dozen others. Israel and Hamas conflicts persist, with 14,000 deaths in Gaza.


Lai Ching-Te Elected President of Taiwan


Pentagon forecast China would have total fleet of 80 attack & ballistic missile submarines by 2035

DoD Budget Increases (\$USD, billions) & Backlog




PB23 aimed to strengthen maritime dominance in defense of US

15 G700 certification planned before end of FY 2023




Delays occurred, pushing back the certification of G700s and G800s





Bear Case

- EV/LTM Revenue: 1.17x (share price of \$262)

Base Case

- Geopolitical tensions continue
- GD sees increased demand in the aerospace segment and US begins repairs on ships

Bull Case

- EV/2024E EBITDA: 17.13x (share price of \$319)
- Fighting emerges in Taiwan, and US gets directly involved with conflicts







D: COMPS FY 2023 Cash Conversion






GD outperforms its competitors in Cash Conversion Rate by a significant margin, making it better suited to take advantage of current conflicts


E: COMPS Customer Concentration




GD Customer Concentration




LTM Customer Concentration



Much of existing submarine technology comes from reverse engineering diesel-electric submarines bought from Russia after collapse of Soviet Union. Possibility of Russia sharing advanced technology with China

China also working on **'Underwater Great Wall'** since 2017, which is a network of sensors over South China Sea and East China Sea

Chinese Stock Market almost at its 5 year low, with many foreign investors selling, totaling around **\$2 billion** worth of Mainland China shares in January despite Beijing's efforts to prop stock market

With China's failed attempts to stimulate the economy, war may become an option for China if it continues to fall

US war games (simulations of conflicts created by DoD) have concluded that China would likely try to bomb jet flue supplies or refueling ships, crippling US air and sea power

United States is trying to spread its military logistic hubs across the region, including warehouses in Australia. Overall, Pacific region has shown sign of weakness for US region, so would need to increase presence there.
