

#### CASE COMPETITIONS




- We hold two case competitions which allow you to learn technical finance that you will use on the job
- Fall 2023: M&A Case Competition
- Spring 2024: Equity Research Case Competition
- Cases are mock financial advisory scenarios where a question is posed and each team must present their solution
  - General Business Case Example: Walmart is facing problems when it comes to brand perception, what should management do to turn around the company?
  - Finance Case Example: Whole Foods received a takeover bid from Amazon, should they accept it?

#### WHY SHOULD I DO A CASE COMPETITION?



- The Finance Society will teach you everything you need to know to successfully complete a case competition
- Case competitions allow you to demonstrate your abilities to upperclassmen, professors, and established alumni
  - These people will help you get referred for jobs, internships, competitions, and programs within SOM
- Finalists present to prominent alumni in New York City at a major financial institution
  - Participants often receive internship or job offers as a result of their participation in the final round


# BINGHAMTON INVESTMENT FUND



#### Gain real world knowledge and valuable experience

- The Binghamton University Investment Fund is a competitive student run fund with ~\$550,000 in assets under management
- The Investment Fund will teach you how to apply your technical knowledge to the real world and how to analyze assets
  - You will be able to utilize this experience in interviews and when talking with alumni, which will be a major asset in getting a job
- Obtain in-depth knowledge of a sector from experienced upperclassmen mentors; work towards becoming a senior analyst
- Applications open up at the end of the spring
  - Freshmen are encouraged to apply


#### WOMEN IN FINANCE



- Women in Finance is a mentorship program focused on introducing female underclassmen to the finance world and developing future financial service industry leaders


## NATIONAL CASE COMPETITIONS



#### Get exposure to industry leaders and represent Binghamton

- The CFA Institute Research Challenge is an Equity Research Competition hosted by the CFA Institute
  - Binghamton won the New York Region in Spring 2021 by beating out 22 graduate school teams
- The Point72 Summer Analyst Case Competition is an Equity Research Competition hosted by an \$11 billion family office
  - Binghamton placed fourth out of over 200 teams in Fall 2015 and received interviews at the firm
- University of Michigan Stock Pitch Competition
  - Binghamton won first place in Fall 2016, beating out numerous Ivy League Schools and winning a \$3,000 case prize

# WHAT DOES FINANCE SOCIETY DO EACH WEEK?
